Table 5. Signs And Symptoms Of Hyperglycemic Emergencies.

Hyperglycemia <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Polyuria—This may be seen as nocturia or enuresis in a previously continent child.• Polydipsia—This may be quite extreme; the patient may report that he or she will set a large glass of water or other liquid at the bedside when going to bed.• Polyphagia• Weight loss—This may be quite dramatic due to the breakdown of protein and fat stores.• Fatigue and weakness—These are common presenting symptoms.• Abdominal pain—The abdominal pain is of uncertain cause or may be due to pancreatitis or another disease that precipitated the DKA. Note that DKA is often mistaken for gastroenteritis.• Nausea and vomiting	Acidosis <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hyperventilation—This is due to the metabolic acidosis. The patient may have peri-oral and limb paresthesias. Acidosis may be mistaken for hyperventilation syndrome.• Altered mental status—This can vary from lethargy to coma. Cerebral Edema <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Decreasing sensoria• Sudden and severe headache• Incontinence• Vomiting• Combativeness, disorientation, agitation• Change in vital signs (hypothermia, hypotension, hypertension, tachycardia, bradycardia, gasping respirations, periods of apnea)• Ophthalmoplegia• Pupillary changes• Papilledema• Posturing, seizures
